This is in addition to products which are already available to you at no cost as WMO additional data sets (https://www.ecmwf.int/en/forecasts/datasets/wmo-and-acmad-datasets).

This offer from the ECMWF Council to the WMO member States has the potential to help all of you save life and property in your nations. In such exceptional circumstances, all you have to do is ask, and we will be in a position to provide you with the real-time data which can make such a huge difference.
