Meeting Venues

The Third Ice Analysts Workshop will take place at the Danish Meteorological Institute, DMI, in Copenhagen. The workshop will start at 09:00, Tuesday, 14 June at the DMI main meeting room. DMI is situated in the north eastern part of Copenhagen and has the S-railway station "Ryparken" next to its premises, Lyngbyvej 100.

Hotels

Single rooms have been pre-booked at 3 hotels. You need to book your room yourself with a booking number that Lisbeth Palle, DMI, +45 39 15 72 20, lap@dmi.dk, will give you, when you register for the Workshop with Lisbeth. Please beware of the dead-lines for booking under each hotel.

Hotel Imperial - Vester Farimagsgade 9, 1606 Copenhagen V

Price incl. breakfast DDK 1318,00. Registration fee for the first night DKK 50,-. Hotel Imperial is a 4 star hotel situated close to the central part of Copenhagen and next to the S-railway station "Vesterport", where you can catch the S-train directly to "Ryparken". Travel time 15 minutes. Choose route "A" and the direction "Farum". Booking before May 23.

Hotel Astoria - Banegårdspladsen 4, 1570 Copenhagen V

Price incl. breakfast DDK 895,00. Hotel Astoria is renovated in 2007. It is a 3 star hotel situated right in the central part of Copenhagen, next to the Central Train Station, where you can catch the S-train directly to "Ryparken". Travel time 19 minutes. Choose route "A" and the direction "Farum". Booking before May 12.

Hotel Centrum – Helgolandsgade 14, 1653 Copenhagen V

Price incl. breakfast DDK 895,00. It is a 3 star hotel situated right in the central part of Copenhagen within 5 minutes walk to the Central Train Station, where you can catch the S-train to "Ryparken". Booking before May 12.

Airport and how to go to DMI

A ride with a taxi from Copenhagen Airport will take 30 minutes or more, if it is during rush hours. The price is about DDK 200,-.

At the Copenhagen Airport there are two different train connections going to Copenhagen. The Metro M2 with frequent departures, and an ordinary train at each 15 minutes. Both train connections are accessed at the far end in the arrival terminal (Terminal 3). The Metro is found one level up, and the ordinary train one level down. We advise using the Metro M2. Choose the direction "Vanløse" and get off at the station "Nørreport". Walk up the stairs, and Choose the S-train with route "A" and the direction "Farum". From the Airport to "Ryparken" travel time is 32 minutes.

Visas

Visitors to Denmark from the Schengen area and many other countries do not require a visa, but just a national, valid passport. To see whether you need a visa and look for visa requirements and applications, please see:

The Danish currency is the Danish Krone (DKK), which is divided into 100 $^\prime$ øre $^\prime$. Ultimo March 2011:

1 DKK = 0.19 US Dollars

1 DKK = 0.13 Euro

How to walk from the S-station "Ryparken" to DMI



Leave the station at the entrance to the left, coming down the stairs.

10 steps to the left, you will find an iron staircase. At the top, follow the path along the lawn, directly to the DMI main entrance and reception, where you will be welcomed.

Ticket system for the Metro, the S-train and the city busses

Ticket cards can be bought from a vending machine. You can use Eurocard, MasterCard, Diners Card, American Express Card and Visa Card. The same ticket card is valid for the Metro, the S-train and city busses. All rides are divided into zones. We recommend to buy a Blue ticket card for DKK 140,00. It is valid for 2 zones. Before entering trains and busses, you must punch your ticket card. Going to Ryparken from Copenhagen Airport involves 4 zones. With a Blue card you need to punch the card twice! Passengers are randomly controlled, and travelling without correct punching costs DKK 600,-.
